The K12 Career Education Navigator is an online tool that highlights high school career education programs across San Bernardino and Riverside Counties. Educators and counselors can use it to explore programs, understand regional offerings, and support students in planning for future opportunities.

EXPLORE

Use the Navigator to view career education programs available at high schools throughout the Inland Empire. Search by district, school, or career field to learn what programs are offered locally and how they expand opportunities for students across the region.

CONNECT

Use the Navigator to identify regional pathway programs, connect with other districts offering similar options, and review how courses are coded in the state system. The tool provides a clear view of programs that can support collaboration and regional pathway planning.

USE

Access information on CTE programs offered within your district and across the region. The Navigator helps educators and counselors stay informed about available pathways, which can guide student course selection and career exploration discussions.

SHARE

Share the Navigator with students and families as a trusted source for exploring local career education options. Use it to point them toward programs, Inland Empire Community Colleges, and Adult Education opportunities that align with their goals and interests.
