START

The K12 Career Education Navigator is an online tool that helps families explore career education programs offered at local high schools. Search by district, school or career field to identify programs offered near you.

SEARCH

Begin by exploring programs that spark your student's interest. Use the filters to view options by school, district, or industry and see what opportunities are available in your area.

DISCUSS

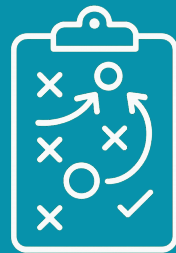
Talk with your student about the programs that interest them most. Use the Navigator's information to guide conversations with teachers or counselors about possible next steps.
